A glazed interior surface and a wider rim opening are just a few of the technical improvements made to the design of the toilet bowl. These modifications ease cleaning and prevent calcification of the bowl. In addition, the water closet's connection to the floor and the joint between the cistern and the bowl have also been hygienically and aesthetically improved.



The design of the new lavatory has an even more elegant expression. The shallow design of the basin reflects considerations of the fact that running water is most often used when washing hands or brushing teeth. Several smaller changes have also been introduced, for example a so called half column has been designed to conceal the drain tap and soil pipe.
